

# SPEAK 3.0

Interdisciplinary artwork from Alejandra Ceriani, Fabricio Costa and Fabián Kesler



## CONCEPT

*"SPEAK 3.0" WORKS ABOUT DIFFERENT RELATIONSHIPS AND REFLECTIONS ABOUT THE BODY, THE SOUND, THE VISUAL IMAGE AND THE TECHNOLOGY AND ON THE PROCESSES OF CHANGE EXPERIENCED IN THE CONTEMPORARY SOCIETY AROUND THE COMMUNICATION-ISOLATION PHENOMENA.*

*A DANCE-PERFORMER, A VISUAL ARTIST AND A SOUND ARTIST CONFORM THE CREATIVE TEAM OF SPEAK 3.0. THEY CREATED ALL THE WORK WITH ITS OWN SOFTWARE, AND ALSO CREATED THE LED BASED ILLUMINATION OF THE WORK.*

*THE STATES OF MOVEMENT AND STILL OF A BODY ARE CAPTURED BY A CAMERA IN SCENE, AND THEN REINTERPRETED IN VISUAL AND SOUND PARADIGMS IN REAL TIME, THAT COMBINE WITH THE AUDIOVISUAL GENERATED MATERIAL AND PROCESSED LIVE, THIS WAY CREATING DIFFERENT RELATIONSHIP STATES BETWEEN THE THREE ARTISTS AND THE TECHNOLOGICAL MEANS, THAT CONCLUDES IN A REAL MULTI-SENSORIAL **CONCERT**, INTERACTIVE AND COMPLETELY ALIVE.*

Bodies that compose sounds at the same time that they compose structures of expressions. The physical interfaces capture the mechanical signs and articulations from the body in scene, transforming them in computational paradigms, and returning them in image configurations and sounds to compose multimedia in realtime, "talking" with the own material from the video man and the musician.

This way, a collective interaction is generated, a crossing of senses, that although it leaves of certain premises and materials, it will never be completely similar to the previous one.

*"Maybe this state of contemporary isolation, paradoxically in the era of the massive communications and hipervelocity, with more and more sophisticated technologies, contains inside the germ of a new kind of communication, where the sensitivity and the intuitive aspects have real value.*

### ***This proposal looks for:***

- To relate the field of the dance with that one of the new technologies, and more specifically, to link the setting and interaction among body-sound-image-technology.
- To upgrade the compositive processes in the fields of the dance, the animation and the music, aiming to the constitution of new metaphors and relationships, according to this era.
- To investigate in the use of new technologies applied to the corporal, plastic, sound and scenic practices that inaugurates a new capacity to create and to experience with that knowledge.
- To discourage the precepts that are commonly preferred in the artistic scenic jargon: "the" musician, "the" dancer, "the" choreographer, "the" visual artist. In this proposal there are not leaders, but rather the commitment and the participation in the work are integrated and shared.

### ***About the different version of SPEAK:***

In their first version of SPEAK, the emphasis was on denoting the preponderance of the artificial means in the communication chain, using iconic elements as a screen, showing on it the deformation of the body seen alive, and a speaker, not only from its sound emission but also visual aspects, based on the movements of its cone that fed in a pertinent way the visual and sound aesthetics of the work.

In the second version it is the interpersonal communication and the expression of intimacy in the current situation of technological and informative saturation, and finally in this third version it is approached, always in metaphoric and subjective way, the talkative violence.

This is: the imposition of messages, the prepotency and the interruption of messages that leaves them truncated, violated, situation that finishes in isolation and incommunication, and finally the possible ways to escape and to find an alternative from the mass-media.



## **THE ARTISTS COUNT**

### ***On the work***

The project was born in 2005, in an encounter of choreographers where Alejandra Ceriani met Fabián Kesler .

In that moment Alejandra presents her "Proyecto Hoseo", an interactive performance.

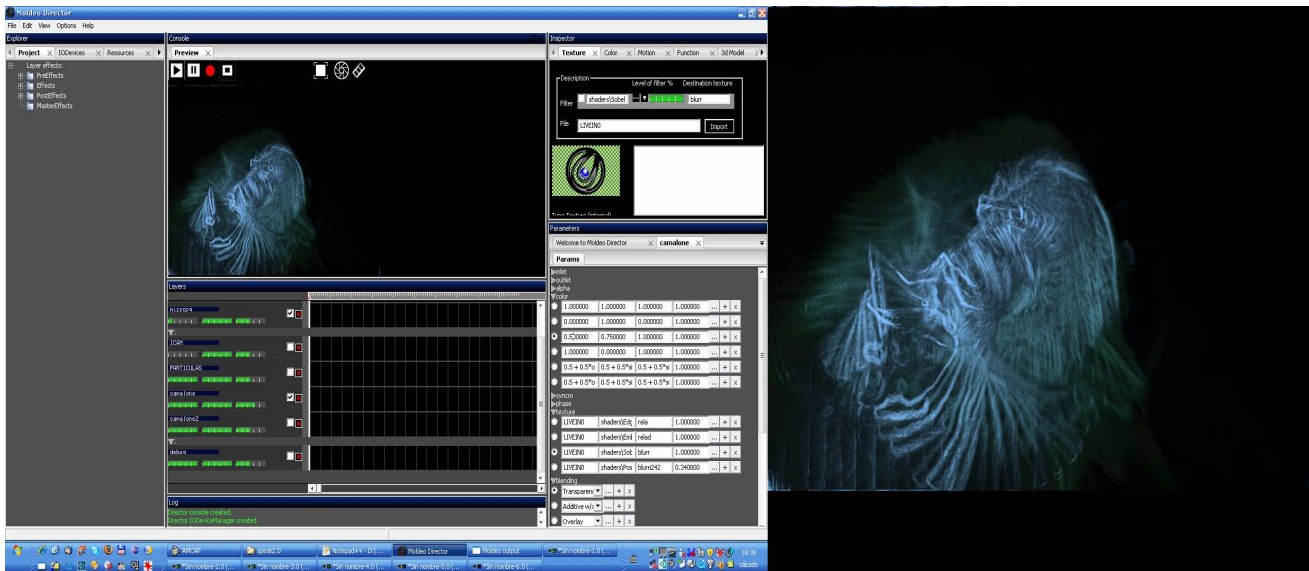
Fabián notices the agreement of the search points and aesthetic experimentation, so they decide to undertake a work on the whole.

A videotape series arises from these encounters. They called them "Speak", in homage to the speaker, icon of the contemporary communication that inspired great part of the aesthetic and conceptual results of the work.

In turn, Speak is a verbe about talking. We also look for a type of non verbal communication in our work, showing the artificial generators as they are: the video screen and the speaker "speaking" in their own ways, opened to the personal interpretation: sounds, speaker's movements generating an own language, body deformed in the screen, at the same time that the real body is in scene.

This 3rd version of the work includes Fabricio Costa Alisedo, designer of the software MOLDEO who is in charge of the visual aspects of Speak 3.0 (movement capture and projection).

***MOLDEO is an open-source code platform, that facilitates the realization of interactive environments with video elements and animation with digital effects in realtime.***



***Snapshot of MOLDEO, the open-source image performance software, created by Fabricio Costa Alisedo and used in SPEAK 3.0***

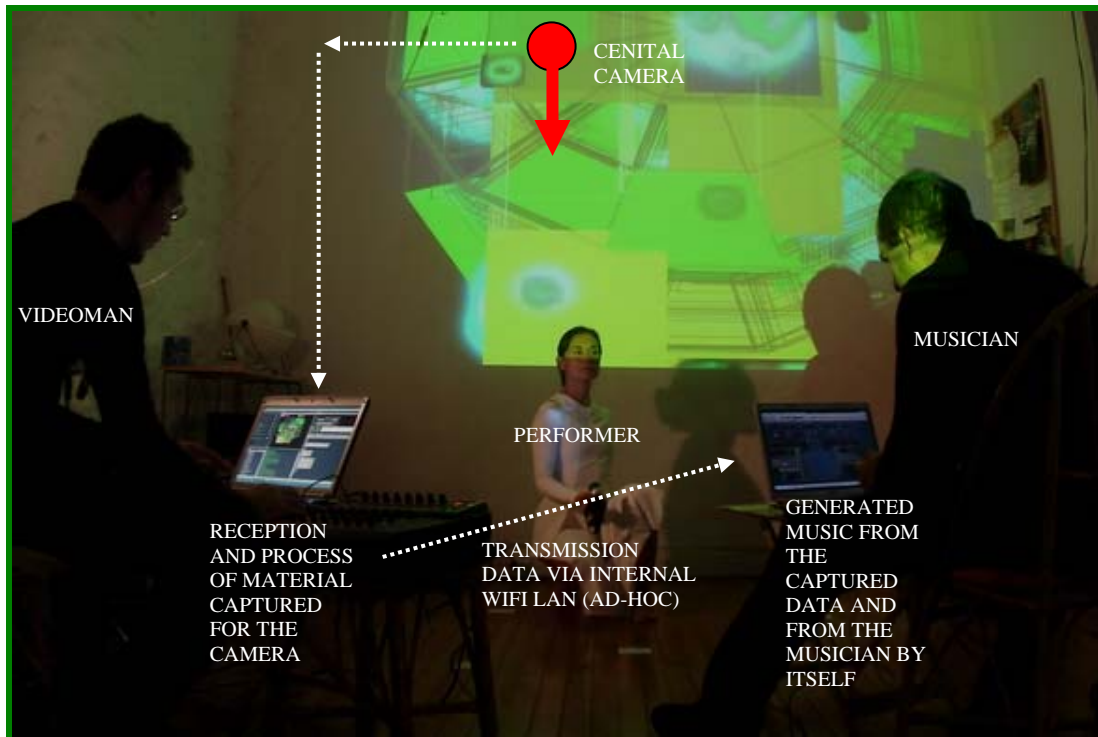
In this case it works like a conversion platform to digital data of the movements captured by the webcam from the dancer-performer Alejandra Ceriani.

Then, the sound of Speak 3.0 consist of the aesthetic reinterpretación of this digital data, plus the music properly generated by Fabián Kesler.

The form of the work is an "orderly improvisation". That is to say: areas defaulted in the work but their duration and the passage from one to another one is not rigid but rather depends on the climates and moments that are generated alive from the interaction. We always leave that small margin for the scenic surprise.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR SPEAK 3.0

- A SURFACE OF ABOUT 3 METERS x 3 METERS (OR MORE)
- A WALL TO PROJECT THE VIDEO MATERIAL
- A CANYON-PROJECTOR (2000 ANSILUM OR MORE) WITH COMPUTER VGA INPUT
- THE POSSIBILITY OF HANGING THE CAMERA (WE USE OUR OWN CAMMERA) NEAR THE FLOOR IN ORDER TO GET A CENTAL CAPTURE OF THE DANCER (SEE THE DRAWING ABOVE): ONE TECHNICIAN IF POSSIBLE TO HELP US, STAIRS AND SOME FIXING SYSTEM FOR THE CAMERA.
- A SOUND SYSTEM, PREFERING SURROUND (BUT WE CAN DO IT ALSO IN A STEREO SYSTEM IF THERE IS NOT SURROUND).
